[REDACTED] was not certain if the person on the ground was a police officer or not. [REDACTED] immediately called "911." [REDACTED] did not have any further information.

Statements:

[REDACTED] was in the Del Taco drive through ordering food. [REDACTED] said he did not see anything from where he was but heard four to five gun shots. [REDACTED] only heard the gun shots and did not have any further information.

Ventura County Fire:

On 10-23-2001, I contacted the Ventura County Fire Department. I was told that Engine #50, 54 and 55 were all dispatched to the officer involved shooting incident. Engine #50 and 54 were cancelled upon arriving at the scene.

Engine #55 was the station that actually responded to the scene. The crews for Engine #55 were as follows: Fire Captain [REDACTED], Fire Engineer [REDACTED] and Fire Fighter [REDACTED]. Dispatch told me the crews were off today and would not be back until 10-27-2001 (four days off).

On 10/22/01, at approximately 1715 hrs., I contacted ██████████ inside "Pier 1 Imports" as a potential witness.

At approximately 1610 hrs., (W) ██████████ was working inside "Pier 1 Imports" when she heard two banging sounds that sounded like someone was hammering outside. During this time a female customer entered the store and said she heard some gun shots in the parking lot near "Del Taco." (W) ██████████ did not know the customer's name.

(W) ██████████ only heard the gunshots and did not have any further information. One of her employees, ██████████ called emergency 911 to report the shooting. Refer to Detective Noel San Jose report regarding ██████████'s statement. This concluded the interview.

Notification of Call

On October 22nd, 2001 at approximately 1610 hours, Sergeant Aranda told me that an officer involved shooting had taken place in the City of Camarillo. Sergeant Aranda asked me to respond to the Del Taco Restaurant, which is located on Las Posas Road in the Camarillo Town Center Shopping Mall.

I arrived at Del Taco at approximately 1625 hours and contacted Detective Joaquin Diaz. Detective Diaz told me that he had spoken with two civilians, who had possibly witnessed all or a portion of the officer involved shooting that took place in the Del Taco parking lot. Detective Diaz escorted these subjects to my location and asked that I interview them. These two subjects were later identified as James Allen Kline and Robert Charles Flynn. I conducted separate interviews with James and Robert. Refer to my supplemental reports for further details regarding these interviews.

Detective De Mattia and I also canvassed the area businesses for other potential witnesses. I contacted a subject by the name of Mark Anthony Green and learned that he had witnessed part of the incident that took place in the Del Taco parking lot. I also conducted an interview with Mark. Refer to my supplemental report of this interview for further details.

Witness Interview



On October 22nd, 2001 at approximately 1645 hours, I interviewed [REDACTED] in regards to an officer involved shooting and assault with a deadly weapon that occurred at the Del Taco parking lot in Camarillo. [REDACTED] was identified as a possible witness to the events that took place at this location. I asked [REDACTED] to sit in my car so that I could interview him in private. This interview was tape-recorded. For the sake of clarity and ease of reading, I have attempted to put [REDACTED]' statement in chronological order. The following is a summary of this interview:

On October 22nd, 2001, [REDACTED] drove his truck into the parking lot of the Boston Market Restaurant, which is located in the Camarillo Town Center Shopping Mall. {The Boston Market is located west of Del Taco in the shopping center.} [REDACTED] had lunch at Boston Market and then decided to walk over to Target. [REDACTED] was walking west across the intersection between Boston Market and Target, when he noticed a green "Ford F-250" truck approaching the intersection. [REDACTED] said he specifically remembered this truck because it turned right towards Del Taco as soon as he cleared the intersection. [REDACTED] told me it was around this time that he heard "five or six gunshots." [REDACTED] initially thought that what he heard was a car backfiring, but then he quickly surmised that it was gunfire. [REDACTED] told me that the gunshots sounded as if they came from two different guns.

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████ continued walking towards Target and stopped by the nursery department. █████ turned around and saw a marked Sheriffs Department patrol car as it "rammed the suspect vehicle" while it was still moving. I asked █████ if he was referring to the "black and white" patrol car. █████ said this was correct. █████ said the suspect vehicle looked as if it had already been crashed, before it was struck by the patrol car on the driver side. █████ stated that it appeared that the patrol car did not cause much damage to the suspect vehicle. I asked █████ if he knew where the heaviest damage was located on the suspect's vehicle. █████ said the majority the damage was on the front end. █████ continued to watch as the suspect put his hands out of the window and was taken into custody. █████ then walked into the Target Store.

I asked █████ to describe the suspect's vehicle. █████ described the vehicle as a "gold colored car with chrome wheels on it." I pointed to a green Ford F-150 truck that was in the Del Taco parking lot (CA, license plate number █████) and confirmed this was the same truck that █████ had seen earlier. I asked █████ if he could identify the driver of the green Ford truck as someone who was possibly involved in this incident. █████ said he had no way of knowing this, because he could not identify the driver of the Ford truck.

I concluded the interview at this time and kept the audiocassette as evidence. I gave the audiocassette to Sergeant Kelley for his case file.

On October 22nd, 2001 at approximately 1700 hours, I interviewed ██████████ ██████████ in regards to an officer involved shooting and an assault on a peace officer, which occurred at the Del Taco parking lot in Camarillo. ██████████ was identified as a possible witness to the events that took place at this location. I asked ██████████ to sit in my car so that I could interview him in private. This interview was tape-recorded. For the sake of clarity and ease of reading, I have underlined ██████████'s initial statement and several of his answers to my follow-up questions. The following is a summary of this interview:

On October 22nd, 2001, ██████████ drove into the Camarillo Town Center Shopping Mall via the West Ventura Boulevard entrance, which runs parallel to the westside of the Texaco Gas Station and the eastside of the Wendy's Restaurant. ██████████ went to the mall so he could buy something to eat at Del Taco. ██████████ had just pulled into the Del Taco parking lot, when he saw "obvious Sheriff's people getting out of vehicles with black vests on; a couple of guys had helmets on." ██████████ then said, "And they were beginning to surround a tan Camry. It appeared to be two people in the vehicle, and there was some shouting; identifying who they were." ██████████ said that a police officer came up to his window and told him to exit his vehicle and leave the area. ██████████ had not yet pulled into the drive-thru lane at Del Taco.

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It was at this time that [REDACTED] saw the suspect vehicle start to move, at which time he also heard the police officers ordering the driver of the vehicle to stop and exit his car. [REDACTED] then heard four or five shots and ducked down in his car. [REDACTED] looked around and saw several marked police vehicles driving up behind him. [REDACTED] was told again to leave the area. [REDACTED] eventually drove out of the Del Taco parking lot and parked across the street.

I asked [REDACTED] if the police officers he saw in the parking lot were dressed in police uniforms, or jackets and vests that were marked with the word "Sheriff." [REDACTED] replied, "Right. Absolutely." [REDACTED] said, "A couple of them had black helmets, but it was the black vests with 'Sheriff' written on it and of course the weapons that kind of got my attention." I asked [REDACTED] if he knew where the suspect vehicle came to rest in relation to where we were now parked. {I was parked near the sidewalk, which is directly south of the Del Taco drive-up menu.} [REDACTED] pointed west and said, "It's over there because after they started shooting...I didn't mention that before, that it hit something. I didn't know what it hit. It kind of, it went out of my site for a little bit and then the shots. And then I saw it come back through and it hit another vehicle and started heading up towards the Oshman's (store) up that way. And then another marked police cruiser came in; I don't think he actually hit the car, but he cornered the car. And then my last recollection is seeing the driver stick his hands out the window."

I asked [REDACTED] if he recalled where the suspect vehicle was parked when he first saw it. [REDACTED] said the suspect vehicle was parked near a silver/gray Nissan truck, which was parked on the north side of the Del Taco parking lot near Pier 1 Imports. [REDACTED] also noticed that the suspect vehicle was backed into the parking stall. I asked [REDACTED] how many people he saw in the suspect vehicle. [REDACTED] said he saw two male subjects in the vehicle, but could not give me a detailed description of their appearance.

I asked [REDACTED] if all of the police officers he saw came in patrol cars. [REDACTED] said that several of the police officers were in unmarked vehicles. [REDACTED] specifically described a black truck and another green colored vehicle. I asked [REDACTED] how many police officers he initially saw when the incident began to take place. [REDACTED] recalled seeing six or seven police officers.

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I asked [REDACTED] if he heard the police officers yell "Sheriffs Department" or "Police Officer" when this incident took place. [REDACTED] said he could not remember exactly what was said, but he was certain that they identified themselves as peace officers. I asked [REDACTED] if he ever heard the sound of squealing of tires or rapid acceleration. [REDACTED] answered, "Oh, hell yeah. They were definitely looking to get out of there, yeah. And then I heard...of course I heard the shots, and then I could see the car again come back through the parking lot towards the officers and it hits...it hit another vehicle. And it kind of look liked it might have gone up over some curbs and eventually all of the marked vehicles came in and cornered it." I asked [REDACTED] if he remembered what vehicle the suspect vehicle collided into. [REDACTED] said he heard the suspect vehicle hit another car, but was not sure what other vehicle it had crashed into. [REDACTED] said he looked at the suspect vehicle as it went by and noticed that the left side of the front end was totaled.

I asked [REDACTED] if he recalled anything else about this incident. [REDACTED] said he remembered seeing another person, who was standing in the immediate area when this incident took place. [REDACTED] described this person as an older adult male with a small dog.

I concluded the interview at this time. I kept the audiocassette as evidence and gave it to Sergeant Kelley for his case file.

On October 22nd, 2001 at approximately 1725 hours, I interviewed ██████████ ██████████ in regards to an officer involved shooting and an assault on a peace officer, which occurred at the Del Taco parking lot in Camarillo. I contacted ██████████ while canvassing the area around the Texaco Gas Station for possible witnesses. ██████████ told me he was doing some concrete repair work at the Texaco Station with two other co-workers when the incident at Del Taco occurred. Refer to Detective De Mattia's supplemental reports for details of her interviews with ██████████'s co-workers. This interview was tape-recorded. The following is a summary of this interview:

██████████ told me he was sitting in his truck making a phone call to his supervisor, when he heard some gunshots. ██████████ looked towards Del Taco and saw a subject in a silver or white pickup, who was surrounded by several officers. ██████████ watched as the subject in the pickup put his hands out the window. The officers than started to chase a "small car" that was eventually hit by a police car. ██████████ said he heard a "couple more shots" and saw the driver of the suspect vehicle put his hands out his window. I asked ██████████ if he heard or saw a collision between two cars. ██████████ said he did not see or hear this, but did hear the gunshots. I asked ██████████ if heard any of the deputies yelling or giving commands to those people in the vehicles he had described. ██████████ said he heard people yelling but could not tell what they were saying because

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he had an earplug in one ear and was talking to his supervisor on the other. I asked [REDACTED] how many gunshots he heard. [REDACTED] estimated that he heard 8 to 12 gunshots.

I asked [REDACTED] if he saw anything else. [REDACTED] said, "I seen the officer down over there. I didn't see him get hit either." I asked [REDACTED] if he saw the injured officer while he was lying on the ground. [REDACTED] answered, "It looked like he was dead. I didn't...he wasn't moving at all. I didn't know he got hit. I thought, I thought he got shot." I asked [REDACTED] what he saw next. [REDACTED] said he then saw one of the marked patrol cars run into the suspect's vehicle. [REDACTED] said he could not hear if the officers were saying anything to the suspects because he had his truck engine and the auxiliary deck engine for his equipment running at the same time.

I concluded the interview at this time and kept the audiocassette as evidence. I gave the audiocassette to Sergeant Kelley for his case file.

On 10-22-01 at approximately 1720 hours, I spoke with ██████████ ██████████ ██████████ told me that he works for the Water Development Company, which is located in Montclair. ██████████ told me that some employees of the company were assigned to work for the day at the Texaco/Starmart gas station, which is located south of the Del Taco parking lot.

██████████ said he didn't see much of the incident, but the first thing he noticed was a patrol car coming into the shopping complex. This entrance of the parking lot that ██████████ was speaking of is the entrance off of Las Posas Road. ██████████ said he noticed the patrol vehicle was coming in quickly and the next thing he heard was gunfire. ██████████ said he was standing behind the company's work vehicle (rig) at the time. ██████████ said the rig was blocking the view of what was occurring between the officers and the suspects. ██████████ said he moved to an area where he could see what was going on. He said he saw a couple of officers shooting towards a Nissan truck. ██████████ pointed out the truck, which was later determined to be the witnesses' vehicle.

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██████████ clarified that the officer's appeared to be shooting at an offset brown Ford Escort (suspect vehicle) that was traveling past the Nissan truck.

██████████ said he thought he heard four to five gunshots total. The two officers he saw that were shooting their weapons at the suspects were in a police uniform. He thought he heard three shots at that time. I questioned him again in regards to the officers that he saw shooting their weapons and he again repeated they were in uniform. ██████████ didn't see any officers shoot their weapons that weren't in uniform. He was unable to give me a description of the uniformed officers that he said did shoot their weapons.

██████████ next saw the suspect vehicle continue west through the Del Taco/Pier 1 Imports parking lot. He saw two different officers (again uniformed) appear to shoot at the suspect's tires. He thought the officers were trying to get the suspects to stop their vehicle. He explained that these officers were facing the suspects.

██████████ saw the patrol car follow the suspect vehicle through the parking lot. The suspect/driver placed his hands out the car window, as if he was surrendering. ██████████ said he couldn't see anything after that because several other patrol vehicles responded to the scene, which blocked his view.

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Fontana, CA 92335

On 10-22-01, at approximately 1740 hours, I spoke with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is also an employee of the Water Development Company in Montclair and was working at the Texaco gas station.

[REDACTED] said he was working behind the rig when he heard four or five loud pops that he equated to a car backfiring. [REDACTED] said he remembered he heard somebody say, "They're shooting." At that time [REDACTED] walked out from behind the rig and noticed a Nissan pickup truck. (Witness vehicle) The driver had his hands out the window. [REDACTED] identified the suspect's vehicle and said he saw the driver go west through the parking lot. [REDACTED] said several officers (approximately four or five) were on foot chasing the suspect vehicle through the parking lot. [REDACTED]'s recollection was that all the officers were in plain clothes. [REDACTED] never saw any officers with their guns drawn, nor did he hear any officers say anything.

[REDACTED] said he next saw a man lying down in between two trucks. [REDACTED] was describing the spot as being just south of where the witness's truck was parked. He pointed to the area of a parking strip and described that as being the area where he saw what he thought was the officer lying down. [REDACTED] thought he was a police officer because he said he saw something on his side, which he thought was a gun. [REDACTED] said that was the last thing he saw, as he wasn't in a position to see anything further.

Both interviews with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were tape-recorded. For further details refer to the cassette tape. The tape will be booked into the crime lab in Ventura County.

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Note: Upon canvassing the businesses near the area of the incident I contacted the manager at the Boston Market. I asked the manager if she knew if anybody witnessed the incident that occurred outside. The manager told me that one of the employees who had already left for the day said he saw what happened. She told me his name was [REDACTED] and he was working at the restaurant with the permission of the work release program. The manager advised me that he would be in the following day between 1000 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

On 10-23-01, at approximately 1500 hours, I contacted [REDACTED] at Boston Market. [REDACTED] was uncooperative with the investigation and refused to answer any questions. [REDACTED] stated that he just wanted to stay out of it and that he didn't really see anything anyways. I returned to the station and learned some of [REDACTED]'s background information. Below is his statistical information.

On October 22, 2001, I was working as a detective in Sheriff's Major Crimes when I monitored a radio call from narcotics requesting code three assistance. I later contacted Sergeant Kelley via radio and he told me that there was an officer involved shooting. Sergeant Kelley further requested I respond to the Del Taco restaurant in the City of Camarillo and assist with the investigation.

Soon after I arrived at the scene I attended a briefing by Commander Purnell and Captain Richie. Following the briefing I was detailed to interview a citizen whose vehicle was struck by the suspect vehicle.

The following is a synopsis of that tape-recorded interview.

Prior to speaking with [REDACTED] I noted that he was standing near a gray Nissan Frontier pick up truck, license [REDACTED] / CA. I also noted minor damage to the rear chrome bumper of the truck and a broken right taillight. There was a considerable amount of clear glass scattered around the right rear side of the pick up.

[REDACTED] told me he at first thought his car was hit by a black BMW. [REDACTED] said he later was looking at the scene and saw a beige Honda car parked at the west end of the parking lot. [REDACTED] said he now felt it was the beige Honda that struck his car.

[REDACTED] said all he saw was "some guy dressed all in black with a gun out, and three other guys come out." [REDACTED] said he saw the guns and heard the gunfire. [REDACTED] said he put both his hands out the window and that was when the other car hit his car.

[REDACTED] said he thought there was a drug deal going on in the parking lot involving some other people who were parked in the parking lot moments before the shooting started.

I asked [REDACTED] to start from the very beginning and tell me what he saw and heard regarding this incident.

[REDACTED] told me he stopped first at the Texaco gas station (Star Mart) to use the restroom. After that [REDACTED] said he drove through the drive thru of Del Taco and parked at the northeast side of the parking lot just west of the drive thru exit.

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█████ said he ate a taco and a half when he heard some yelling. █████ said he looked back behind his truck and saw a man dressed all in black with his gun drawn approaching a car (suspect vehicle) parked two or three parking stalls east of the green truck (Deputy Capuano's Vehicle).

█████ said he also saw two more men running towards the suspect vehicle. █████ said at that point the suspect vehicle sped out of the parking space eastbound towards the Del Taco. █████ said he put his head down and his hands out the window. █████ said a few seconds later his car was hit by the suspect vehicle. █████ said after his car was hit he heard gunfire.

█████ said he was able to see officers west of his location and saw an officer lying on the ground. █████ said at the same time he saw the suspect vehicle crash into another car at the intersection where the main road travels across the front of the business north of Del Taco.

█████ said he didn't see the officer get hit by the suspect vehicle.

I asked █████ if he saw the suspect vehicle drive out or back out of its parking space. █████ said he didn't notice. I asked █████ if he saw the suspect vehicle drive the wrong way into the drive thru. █████ said he didn't see the suspect vehicle go into the drive thru. █████ said he put his head down and didn't see anything until after the shooting stopped.

I asked █████ if he noticed after his car was struck whether the suspect vehicle was driving away or backing away. █████ said the suspect car was driving away. Then █████ changed his story and said the suspect car could have been backing away he didn't remember.

I asked █████ if he saw the suspect crash at the west end of the parking lot. █████ said he didn't see the suspect vehicle stop. █████ said he did not notice how many people were in the suspect vehicle.

I confirmed with █████ that he was not hurt. █████ said most of the damage to his car was to his rear bumper.

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I asked [REDACTED] if he could tell by the way they were dressed if the people with the guns were police. [REDACTED] said, "Not at all, not until I saw the type of gun did I think they could be police." [REDACTED] also stated, "then I saw the helmets with police written on the back."

On 10/22/01 at approx. 1615 hours, I was working as a plain-clothes investigator in the City of Camarillo. I went to the parking lot area adjacent to Del Taco at 121 W. Ventura Blvd. to assist Narcotics officers at the scene of an officer involved shooting.

Upon arriving at the scene, I checked in at the Incident Command Post. Initially, I was assigned to interview (V) Perry Dennis, a bystander whose vehicle was struck by the suspect vehicle.

Statement of (V) [REDACTED]

I contacted [REDACTED] as he stood next to his vehicle, which was parked near the exit of the Del Taco drive-thru lane. [REDACTED] told me the following: Shortly after 4:00 PM, he stopped at the Del Taco restaurant (drive-thru window) and got something to eat. He parked his vehicle and began eating in the car. Suddenly, he heard people yelling. [REDACTED] looked in his rear-view window and noticed some men (dressed in black) with shotguns drawn, approaching a vehicle. The vehicle quickly pulled out of the parking spot, headed East toward the drive-thru exit (against traffic). [REDACTED] then heard gunshots, so he thrust his hands out of his window. The suspect vehicle stopped, turned around, and struck the rear end of his vehicle. The suspect vehicle continued Westbound, striking another vehicle before stopping.

[REDACTED] seemed a little confused about which car had struck his. At first, he described it as a black BMW, but it soon became apparent that the suspect vehicle was silver.

Officer Actions

After interviewing [REDACTED] I spoke with a male subject (who had arrived after the incident) near the adjacent Petco store. He told me that he had spoken with a woman who claimed to have seen the entire incident after leaving the pet store. He described her as an attractive blond woman, who drove away in a green Honda. I went to the Petco store and had the manager run cash register reports to identify customers who had made purchases between 3:40 PM and 4:15 PM. I released the reports (with names, addresses, and phone numbers) to Sgt. T. Lorenzen of Major Crimes.

On 10-22-2001, I was dispatched to assist in the investigation of an officer involved shooting incident at the Target Center in Camarillo. Part of my assignment in the investigation was to interview the Fire Department crew who responded to the scene.

On 10-23-2001, I learned that Ventura County Fire Department Engine-50, 54 and 55 were all dispatched to the incident. Engine 50 and 54 were cancelled by their dispatch upon arrival. Engine-55 was the crew that actually responded and arrived at the scene. The crews for Engine-55 were as follows: Fire Captain Gary [REDACTED], Fire Engineer [REDACTED] and Fire Fighter [REDACTED].

On 10-31-2001, at about 0830 hours, I interviewed the above listed fire personnel.

Fire Captain [REDACTED] Statement:

On 10-22-2001, at about 1646 hours, Fire Captain [REDACTED], Fire Engineer [REDACTED] and Fire Fighter [REDACTED] arrived at the scene. Fire Captain [REDACTED] told me that upon arriving at the scene, he surveyed the situation and gathered information on the number of injured person. Captain [REDACTED] later assisted an AMR medic in placing the suspect on a spine board and into an ambulance. The suspect was then transported to the hospital. Captain [REDACTED] told me the suspect did not make any statements to him.

Fire Engineer [REDACTED]:

On 10/22/01 at approx. 1615 hours, I was working as a plain-clothes investigator in the City of Camarillo. I went to the parking lot area adjacent to Del Taco at 121 W. Ventura Blvd. to assist Narcotics officers at the scene of an officer involved shooting.

I then contacted each of the above listed personnel and interviewed them separately. I tape-recorded each of the interviews.

Statement of (P1) [REDACTED]

On 10/22/01, I interviewed [REDACTED] in person at the Columbia HCA Los Robles Regional Medical Center in Thousand Oaks. He told me the following: at approx. 1600 hrs., he and his partner Steve [REDACTED] were driving N/B on US101 at Dawson Dr., covering the Camarillo area. They were dispatched to a report of a shooting at (Ventura Blvd. @ Las Posas Rd.). Dispatch advised them that there were four victims.

Upon arriving at the scene, they found out that no one had been shot. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were directed to an officer (Ventura PD Officer [REDACTED]), who was lying on the asphalt. [REDACTED] treated the first officer (whose injuries were non-life threatening) while

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██████████ was asked to examine another officer for injuries. After clearing the second officer, ██████████ helped with the two suspects. The suspect on the passenger side of the (suspect) vehicle had no injuries. The driver of the (suspect) vehicle complained of pain to his neck and back. ██████████ also noted that the 2nd suspect had blood near the area of his mouth. ██████████ placed the 2nd suspect in a "full C-Spine" and readied him for transport to VCMC, although another rescue unit ended up transporting the suspect to the hospital.

██████████ said that he didn't hear either of the suspects make any spontaneous statements about the incident.

██████████ and ██████████ ended up transporting Officer Romero to St. John's Medical Center.

Statement of (P2) ██████████ ██████████

I also interviewed ██████████ in person at the Columbia HCA Los Robles Regional Medical Center in Thousand Oaks. He told me the following: at approx. 1607 hrs. that afternoon, he and his partner (██████████) were dispatched to a report of four victims with gunshot wounds in Camarillo. They were the first ambulance unit to arrive at the scene (Fire Dept. personnel were already there). They soon found that Officer Romero had the most significant injuries, having been struck by a vehicle. ██████████ treated Officer Romero (whose injuries consisted mainly of back pain and abrasions) while ██████████ went on to examine the other potential patients.

██████████ said he stayed with Officer Romero most of the time, leaving his side only to get a briefing from ██████████. ██████████ did not have any contact with either of the suspects.

██████████ placed Officer Romero in a "full C-Spine" as a precaution. He and ██████████ then transported Romero to St. John's Medical Center for treatment.

Statement of (P3) ██████████ ██████████

On 10/31/01, I interviewed ██████████ by telephone. He told me the following: on 10/22/01 at approx. 1600 hrs., he and his partners were working in Camarillo on a cover assignment. ██████████ was working as an Attendant, training Paramedic Intern (P) ██████████. Dispatch sent their unit to respond to four shooting victims (which was soon changed to just one shooting victim). Soon thereafter, their response was cancelled, but later reassigned. Their unit was the second ambulance to arrive at the scene (after Rescue Unit #451).

Upon arriving, Paramedic ██████████ ██████████ briefed ██████████ (and his partners) on the situation. ██████████ treated the driver of the suspect vehicle, who was complaining of neck and back pain. ██████████ said the suspect had already been placed in a cervical collar

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and loaded on a backboard (both wrists handcuffed to the board). A police officer remained with the suspect throughout the treatment and subsequent transport. They loaded the suspect onto the ambulance (accompanied by the officer) and transported him to VCMC for treatment.

At some point during [REDACTED]'s contact with the suspect, he asked the suspect, "What happened?" The suspect told him that he crashed (the vehicle) and blacked out. The suspect told [REDACTED] that when he regained consciousness, somebody told him to stay still and keep his hands there (in plain view).

[REDACTED] and his crew delivered the suspect to the VCMC Emergency Room. The officer remained with the suspect.

Statement of (P4) [REDACTED]

On 11/05/01, I interviewed [REDACTED] by telephone. He told me the following: on 10/22/01 at approx. 1600 hrs., he was working as the driver of AMR Rescue Unit #451 with Paramedic [REDACTED] and Intern [REDACTED]. They were dispatched to the scene of a shooting with multiple patients, at the Target shopping center in Camarillo. They arrived approx. 8-10 minutes after receiving their call (they were cancelled and then reassigned). The scene was secured when they arrived.

They were directed to transport a subject who had been "pre-packaged" (placed on a backboard, wearing a cervical collar). They loaded the patient (a suspect) into their ambulance and transported him to VCMC. [REDACTED] did not hear the suspect make any statements.

Statement of (P5) [REDACTED]

On 10/31/01, I interviewed [REDACTED] by telephone. He told me the following: on 10/22/01 he was working as a paramedic in AMR Rescue Unit #451 in the City of Camarillo. They ([REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]) were dispatched to the scene (of a reported shooting), were cancelled, and then reassigned to the scene to transport patients.

[REDACTED] said they were the second ambulance unit to arrive at the scene. The scene was already secured when they arrived. They were directed to the driver of the suspect vehicle, who was complaining of neck pain from the vehicle collision. They loaded the suspect (who was in "full C-Spine") into the back of the ambulance and performed another assessment. The suspect had some oral trauma, but was alert and oriented and complained of neck & back pain. They transported the suspect (accompanied by an officer) to VCMC for treatment. [REDACTED] rode in the rear of the ambulance as an attendant. During [REDACTED]'s contact with the suspect, he (the suspect) told him that he struck several vehicles as he was leaving the parking lot, then stopped and put his hands

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out of the window as ordered. The suspect told [REDACTED] that he had been knocked out. He (the suspect) also said he was sorry. [REDACTED] didn't hear him say anything further. [REDACTED] and his partners then transported the suspect to VCMC, where they released him to the care of the hospital ER staff.

Statement of (P6) [REDACTED]

On 10/31/01, I interviewed [REDACTED] by telephone. He told me the following: on 10/22/01, he was working as a paramedic in AMR Rescue Unit 452. He and his partner ([REDACTED]) were dispatched to assist at the scene of a shooting in Camarillo. They were assigned to transport a 3rd patient to the hospital. Upon arriving at the scene, they were briefed on the condition of their assigned patient (passenger in the suspect vehicle), who was complaining of neck and back pain.

The suspect was able to walk to the gurney on his own. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] loaded the suspect into their ambulance. [REDACTED] waited outside for a detective to give them clearance to transport the suspect to the hospital.

After receiving clearance, [REDACTED] (who drove the ambulance) and [REDACTED] transported the suspect to VCMC, with a detective following in a separate vehicle. They released him to medical staff at the VCMC Emergency Room.

Statement of (P7) [REDACTED]

On 10/24/01, I interviewed [REDACTED] by telephone. He told me the following: on 10/22/01 he and his partner ([REDACTED]) were at Pleasant Valley Hospital (on an unrelated incident) when they were dispatched to respond to the scene of the officer involved shooting to transport a 3rd patient.

The other ambulances had already gone when [REDACTED] arrived at the scene. They were directed to transport a suspect to VCMC for treatment and clearance. [REDACTED] told me that the suspect had been seated in the rear passenger seat of the suspect vehicle.

Officers at the scene placed a tape-recorder in the back of the ambulance before the suspect was loaded on-board. [REDACTED]'s conversation with the suspect was recorded as they drove to the hospital. [REDACTED] told me that the suspect said the following: he lives in Wilmington and drove to Ventura County to help a friend with some business. His friend wouldn't tell him what the "business" was exactly, but offered to give him some marijuana in exchange for helping him. The suspect said he rode in the rear passenger seat. When they got to (the scene), his friend drove up to somebody and made some kind of an exchange. Suddenly, his friend drove away, headed into the exit of a restaurant drive-thru lane and tried to turn around. The suspect in the rear seat said he heard

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gunshots, so he ducked his head down. The driver struck something with the car two times before stopping.

Wilmarth said he didn't ask any questions about the incident, but did advise the suspect to tell the truth (in the future). He and [REDACTED] dropped the suspect of at VCMC, where they released him to medical staff and detectives.

On 10-22-01 at approximately 1415 hours, I was working in my office (Major Crimes Bureau) when Sergeant Mike Aranda informed me of an "Officer Involved" shooting incident that just occurred in the City of Camarillo. I drove to the Target shopping center and arrived on scene of the shooting at approximately 1630 hours. The exact location of the shooting incident was within the parking lot of the Del Taco restaurant at 121 W. Ventura Blvd. This area is located at the extreme east end of the Target shopping center, and is just west of Las Posas Road.

Upon arriving at the scene, I saw several black and white Sheriff's/Police patrol cars and uniformed Sheriff's deputies establishing a perimeter around the scene with yellow crime scene tape. (Refer to crime scene report by Detective Jose Rivera for details)

At approximately 1645 hours, I was advised by Captain Kelly Fadler that I would be assigned as the case agent for this investigation. I next met with other Major Crimes investigators and coordinated a preliminary briefing of the incident. Captain Mark Ritchie, Ventura County Narcotics Task Force, provided the details of a narcotics investigation that preceeded the shooting incident involving several officers assigned to the task force investigation. Captain Ritchie provided the following information.

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Captain Ritchie stated that members of the Ventura County Narcotics Task Force had been engaged in a two week methamphetamine narcotics investigation. Senior Deputy Steve Capuano (U/C) had negotiated the purchase of four pounds of methamphetamine from two suspects (identified as S1-Rubio & S2-Camez). A surveillance of the suspects began earlier in the day in the Wilmington area, and the suspects were subsequently followed to the designated meeting location in the parking lot of the Del Taco restaurant in Camarillo (121 W. Ventura Blvd.).

During the surveillance activity, the suspect was observed stopping on Las Posas Road, and removing a package from the trunk of his car just prior to meeting with Senior Deputy Capuano. The suspect placed the package in the back seat area of his car and drove to the designated meet location where he parked next to the vehicle driven by Senior Deputy Capuano (Del Taco parking lot). Senior Deputy Capuano met with the suspects and subsequently announced the "bust" signal to alert other narcotics officers to move in to make the arrest on the suspects.

Captain Ritchie identified the "bust" team members as Sheriff's Senior Deputies E. Reyes & B. Lattin, and VPD Officer R. Romero. Captain Ritchie also identified the "cover" team members as Sheriff's Senior Deputy E. Nelson and OPD Officer K. Tougas. He explained that the "bust" team was designated to respond to the location of the suspects when the signal was given by Senior Deputy Capuano to effect the arrest of the suspects, and the "cover" team was responsible for responding to provide security for Senior Deputy Capuano.

Captain Ritchie explained that when the "bust" signal was broadcasted over the radio by Senior Deputy Capuano, all assigned team members acted in accordance to their assignments. When the "bust" team approached the suspect vehicle to make the arrests, S1-Rubio quickly drove away in an effort to escape. S1-Rubio drove through the parking lot with officers pursuing him on foot and ordering him to stop. During S1-Rubio's escape efforts, he nearly hit several officers with his car, collided with another civilian vehicle, hit VPD Officer Romero, collided with a vehicle driven by Sheriff's Senior Deputy H. Laubacher, and was subsequently stopped and arrested by patrol personnel driving marked patrol cars who responded to assist the narcotics

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teams. During this pursuit activity, several officers from the narcotics task force discharged their duty firearms at the suspect vehicle in an effort to force S1-Rubio to comply with directions to stop, and curtail his vehicle assaults against the officers and citizen bystanders in the area. Captain Ritchie described S1-Rubio's driving as reckless and endangering, and explained that S1-Rubio had collided with a parked vehicle just prior to the head-on collision with Senior Deputy Laubacher's truck.

Captain Ritchie identified the officers who discharged their weapons as Sheriff's Senior Deputies Reyes & Nelson, and OPD Officer Tougas. He also identified VPD Officer Romero as the officer who was injured after being struck by S1-Rubio's car. Captain Ritchie advised us that S1-Rubio and S2-Camez had been taken into custody and transported to the hospital for treatment of injuries sustained during the event, and also stated that Officer Romero had been transported to the hospital for treatment of his injuries sustained after being struck by S1-Rubio's car.

At the time of the briefing with Captain Ritchie, it was not known whether either suspect was injured by gunfire. Captain Ritchie stated that Senior Deputy Reyes fired 3-4 rounds at the suspect's tires, and that the background was the wall of the Pier 1 Imports business just north of the parking lot. Captain Ritchie did not know any specific details regarding the number of rounds, direction of fire, or intended targets of either Senior Deputy Nelson or OPD Officer Tougas at the time they discharged their weapons.

Captain Ritchie further explained that the Narcotics Task Force had been engaged in this narcotics investigation for approximately two weeks. The case began with an undercover drug transaction between Senior Deputy Capuano and S1-Rubio for one ounce of crystal methamphetamine. The investigation evolved into an arranged transaction between Senior Deputy Capuano and S1-Rubio for the purchase of four pounds of crystal methamphetamine. The transaction was planned to occur in the parking lot of the Del Taco restaurant in Camarillo and ultimately resulted in this shooting incident. 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At the conclusion of the briefing, I began designating investigative task assignments to assisting personnel on scene. I then conducted a walk through of the crime/shooting scene with Sergeant Lorenzen and Senior Deputy Panza. We discovered three separate and distinct locations in the parking lot where spent shell casings were ejected onto the ground. We also located a civilian vehicle (V- [REDACTED]) and Senior Deputy Laubacher's vehicle that were damaged by S1-Rubio during his efforts to flee.

I next coordinated the crime scene processing and collection of evidence. Senior Deputy Panza conducted walk through interviews with each of the involved officers assigned to the narcotics investigation. Sergeants Aranda and Powers conducted the search and seizure of S1-Rubio's vehicle. All traffic/collision investigation was conducted by Senior Deputy John Popp (Camarillo PD). All evidence at the scene was photographed, processed, and collected by Sheriff's Bureau of Investigation personnel. Suspect and witness interviews were conducted by designated investigative personnel. (Refer to supplemental reports for details of specific areas of investigation)

The crime scene investigation concluded at approximately 0030 hours oon 10/23/01.

Response

On 10/22/01, I responded to the above incident and arrived at approximately 1635 hours.

At 1642 hours, I attended a briefing given by Capt. Ritchie. Ritchie gave several of us a summary of what had occurred. He told us that Det. Capuano was working undercover and had made arrangements to purchase four pounds of "crystal meth" from a subject later identified as Alejandro "Alex" Rubio. This suspect was the driver of the car, which was pointed out to us in the west end of the parking lot. I could see major collision damage to the front end as well as to the driver's side of the vehicle.

Capt. Ritchie also told us the "bust team" was comprised of Detective Romero, Det. Reyes, and Det. Lattin, who were assisted by two black and white units. He also said the "cover team" for Capuano was Detective Nelson and Tougas. The outside perimeter was Detectives Macias, Diaz, Laubacher, and Morales.

Capt. Ritchie further advised us, that as the "bust team" attempted to arrest the two suspects in the silver vehicle, the driver attempted to flee by driving eastbound in the parking lot toward "Del Taco". After the driver realized that he could not exit, he began to rapidly back up and struck a silver pick up truck parked along the north edge of the parking lot. Ritchie added

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that after the suspect struck the parked truck, Det. Reyes shot out a rear tire. Ritchie told us there were four shell casings on the ground as he pointed out an area north west of the "Del Taco" building. Ritchie also pointed out (from a distance) that there were two additional shell casings on the ground, which he thought were either from Tougas or Nelson. Ritchie said both officers fired their weapons, but he was not sure where they were standing when each shot. Ritchie continued by saying the suspect then crashed into Det. Laubacher who was attempting to block the suspect's escape with his truck. He added that after hitting Laubacher's truck, the suspect continued westbound through the parking lot to the point where the car came to rest. At this time, two suspects were taken into custody by officers in black and white units. They were identified as Alejandro "Alex" Rubio 25 years from Wilmington (the driver) and the passenger, Peter Joseph Camez 7/21/81.

At one point, a question was asked in reference to the suspects being transported to the hospital and if anyone had been hit by gunfire. Capt. Ritchie told us that nobody was hit by gunfire, but Det. Romero was struck by the suspect's vehicle as they attempted to flee.

After the briefing, I was detailed to ascertain from the officers how many times they fired their weapons and the direction in which they fired, to assist us in our investigation.

I contacted the detectives and spoke briefly to each one. Det. Reyes told me he thought he fired three or four times, but was not sure. I then asked Det. Tougas how many times he fired his weapon. He said he thought it was once. When I asked Det. Nelson the same question, he told me he was not sure, but thought it might have been twice.

After obtaining this information, I briefed Sgt. Kelley and several other detectives that were there to assist. At one point, Sgt. Kelley and I walked through the scene and looked at shell casings and bullet strikes on the ground in an attempt to get an overall picture as to the events that took place, and to account for all bullets that may have gone down range from the scene. (Refer to photos and markers for items).

At approximately 1717 hours, I was asked by Sgt. Kelley to obtain overall (full body) photographs of the officers involved in the shooting. I met with the officers inside a command post and out of public view. There I had FET [REDACTED] photograph each of the officers in their

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respective uniform and gear that was worn when they attempted to take the two suspects into custody.

The officers photographed were Det. Reyes, Det. Lattin, Det. Tougas (OXPD), Det. E. Nelson, and Det. Capuano.

While inside the command post, I had FET [REDACTED] photograph each of the officers weapons prior to FET [REDACTED] collecting them as evidence.

At 1732 hours, I spoke to Det. Reyes who told me he had unloaded his weapon (Galil) prior to our arrival. The weapon was in a black nylon zippered case with three pouches on the outside for the magazines. Reyes showed me the top pouch that contained a magazine with hollow-tip bullets. He also explained that this was the magazine that was in the gun at the time of the shooting. He also showed me the top bullet, which had a gouge in the brass portion of the bullet.

I asked Reyes how many bullets he had in the magazine. He said he thought there were 35. Based on the number of bullets still contained in the magazine and the position of the damaged bullet, I decided not to unload the magazine, and put it back into the outside pouch from where it had come.

At 1737 hours, I spoke to Det. Nelson and had FET [REDACTED] photograph his weapon (Sig Saur 9 mm) after it was unloaded. While unloading the pistol, I counted the bullets. There was one in the chamber and 13 in the magazine for a total of 14. I asked Nelson if he normally carried the magazine full (15) and one in the chamber, and he said he did.

After Nelson's weapon was turned over to FET [REDACTED] Sgt. Johnston from Personnel replaced it with an alternate gun.

At 1745 hours, Det. Tougas (OXPD) surrendered his Beretta 9mm pistol. The pistol was photographed and when unloaded, it was found to have one round in the chamber and 13 in the magazine. The Beretta was secured by FET [REDACTED] who later booked all the weapons into evidence. Det. Tougas told me that his weapon had already been replaced by his department.

After the weapons of those officers who were involved in the shooting were replaced, Det. Panza and I then searched the area along the south wall of Trader Joe's for any bullet strikes. After we did not locate anything, I then walked the parking lot looking at vehicles that

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may have been in the line of fire. At one point, I saw what appeared to be a bullet strike on the rear chrome bumper of the silver truck that was originally backed into by the suspects in their attempt to flee. I pointed this bullet strike out to Sgt. Kelley. Refer to photos.

At 2047 hours, I sat down with Det. Diaz (VSO Narcotics) inside the command post and interviewed him about his assignment and what he saw of the shooting. Refer to interview report.

At approximately 2130 hours, Sgt. Kelley asked Sgt. Aranda and I to interview the suspects who were in custody at the headquarters station. Both Aranda and I then drove to the station and conducted interviews with both suspects. Refer to interview reports.

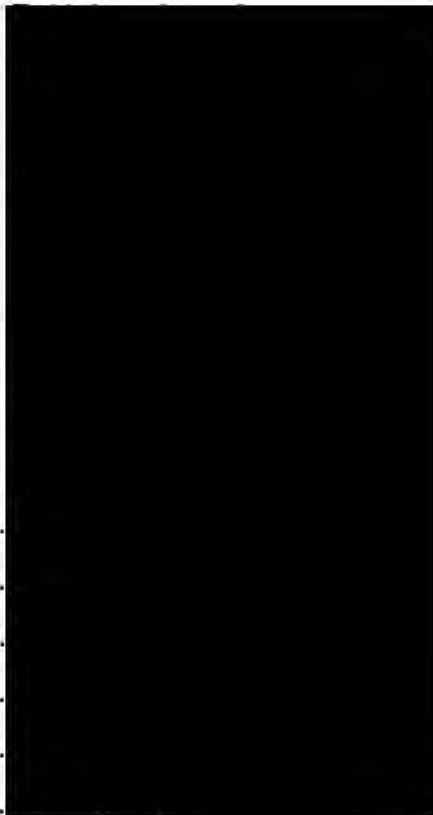

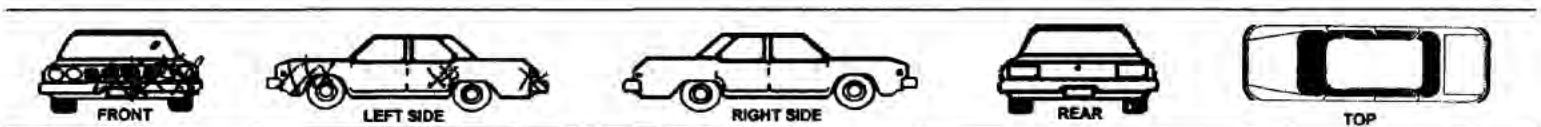
