would also be trimmed under the cost-reduction plan. The county library system will lose 50% of the state revenue it receives under cuts proposed for the current fiscal year by Davis.

However, there is a chance the money will be restored by the Legislature. That possibility improved Friday when a state Assembly committee voted to block the cuts, Kreissman said. The employees will be terminated by Feb. 15 if the dollars do not come through.

Cities with affected libraries may also decide to come up with their own funds, Kreissman said. Fillmore has already voted to do so, and Ojai and Port Hueneme are scheduled to discuss the matter, she said.

But with the state facing a \$35-billion shortfall in the coming year, nothing is certain, she said. Overall, the library system has seen state revenue drop from \$750,000 in 2000 to \$201,000 this year.

"It's a huge cut — 72% in three years," she said.

The state began sending Public Library Fund money to counties in the early 1980s, after Proposition 13 cut local property tax revenue. The money was intended to equalize library funding for those cities that did not collect enough in local tax revenue to provide services, Kreissman said.

Other Ventura County cities that are part of the county library system, such as Simi Valley and Camarillo, are not affected because their property taxes are sufficient to cover costs, the library director said. In Los Angeles, the county library system is facing a \$1.6-million cut in revenue, said spokeswoman Nancy Mahr.

That will translate into 45,000 fewer books purchased, Mahr said. So far, no layoffs or reduced hours are being considered at the county's 84 libraries, she said.

However, the bigger question is how much will Los Angeles libraries lose next year, Mahr said. "We are waiting," she said. "It is going to impact service at some

point." Ventura County is being hit much harder because it has little wiggle room in its budget, Kreissman said. "Everybody talks about fat in government," she said. "There is no fat in the library system."

Ventura Police Officer Jeff Ryan Brooks, son of county Sheriff Bob Brooks, was never fingerprinted or booked into jail.

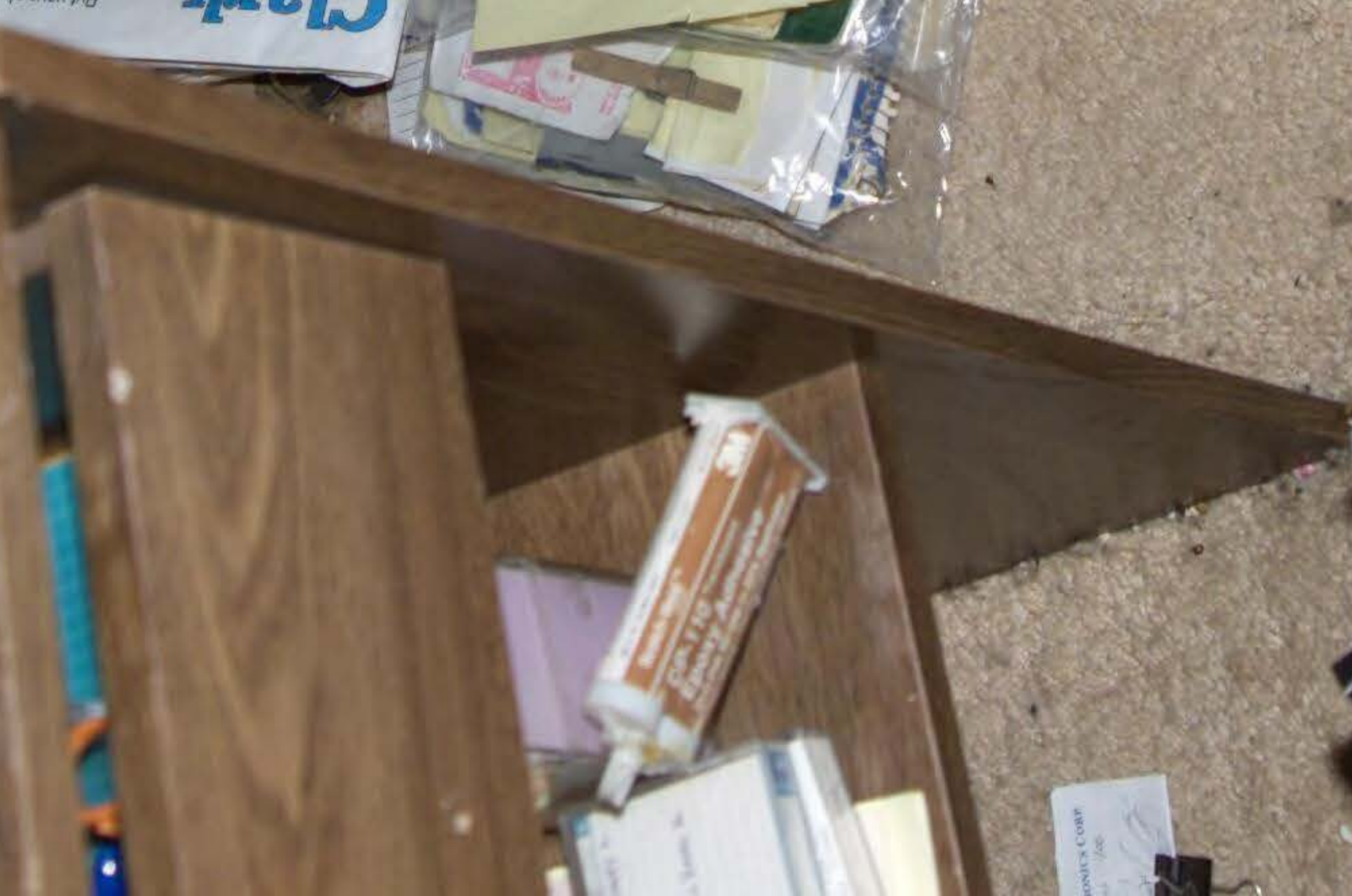
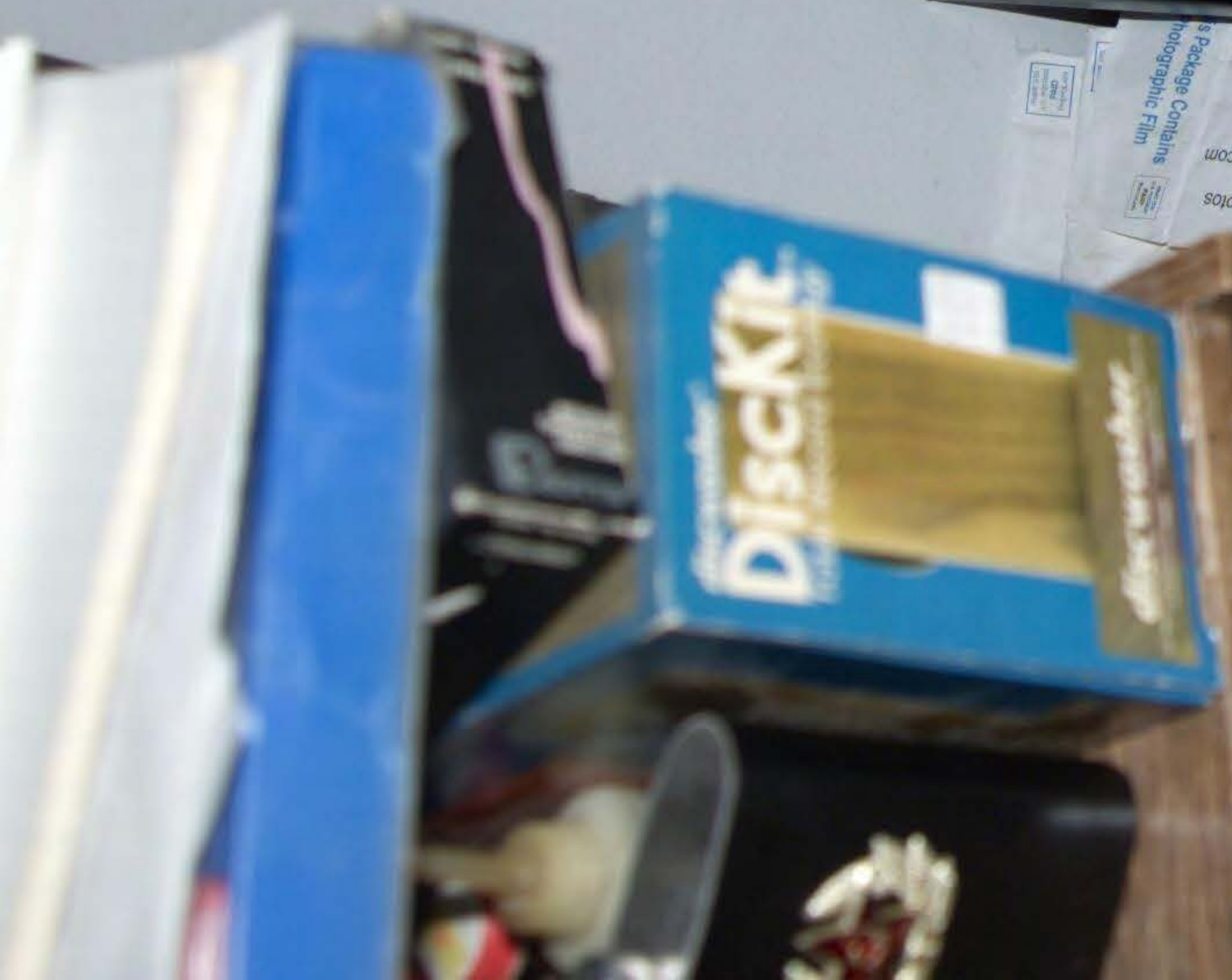

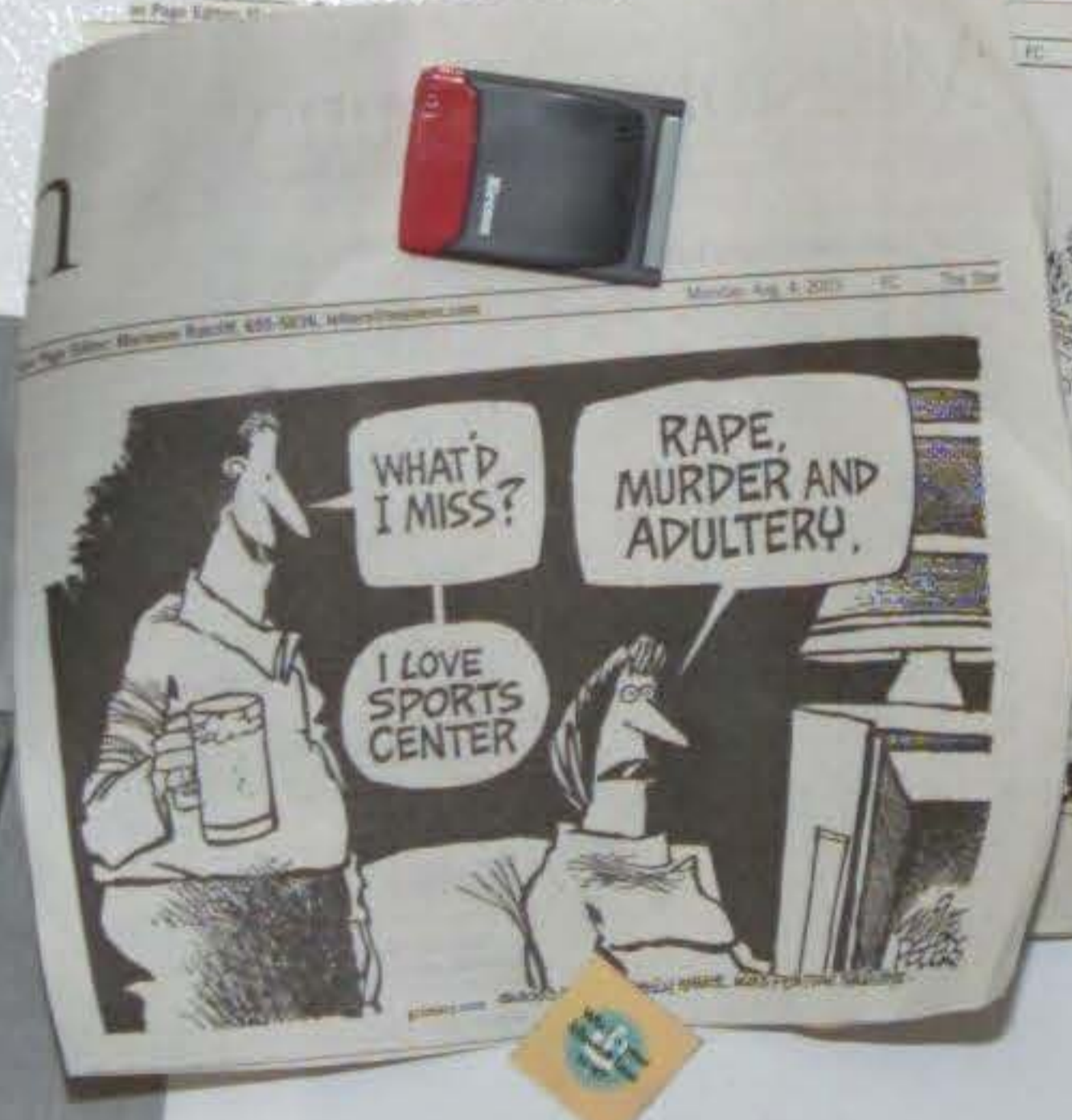

4 arrested after attacks, vandalism

 Fillmore police arrested four men during probation searches Wednesday in response to a series of attacks on deputies by people suspected of being gang members who spray-painted threats on a police storefront, authorities said.

No arrests were made in the attacks or vandalism, but the four men were arrested on probation or parole violations or outstanding warrants, Fillmore Police Sgt. Joe Galante said.

Arrested were Manuel Estrada, 18; Christian Cardoza, 19; Alfredo Martinez, 19; and Jesus Ramirez, 22, all of Fillmore.

Deputies also seized stolen checks, credit cards, and narcotics paraphernalia, Galante said. Other charges against the men are pending, he said.

The first attack on deputies occurred four weeks ago when possible gang members lobbed bottles and pieces of metal at deputies on patrol, he said.

Police thought the attack was a retaliatory incident, but the spray-painted threats, Galante said, were damaged.

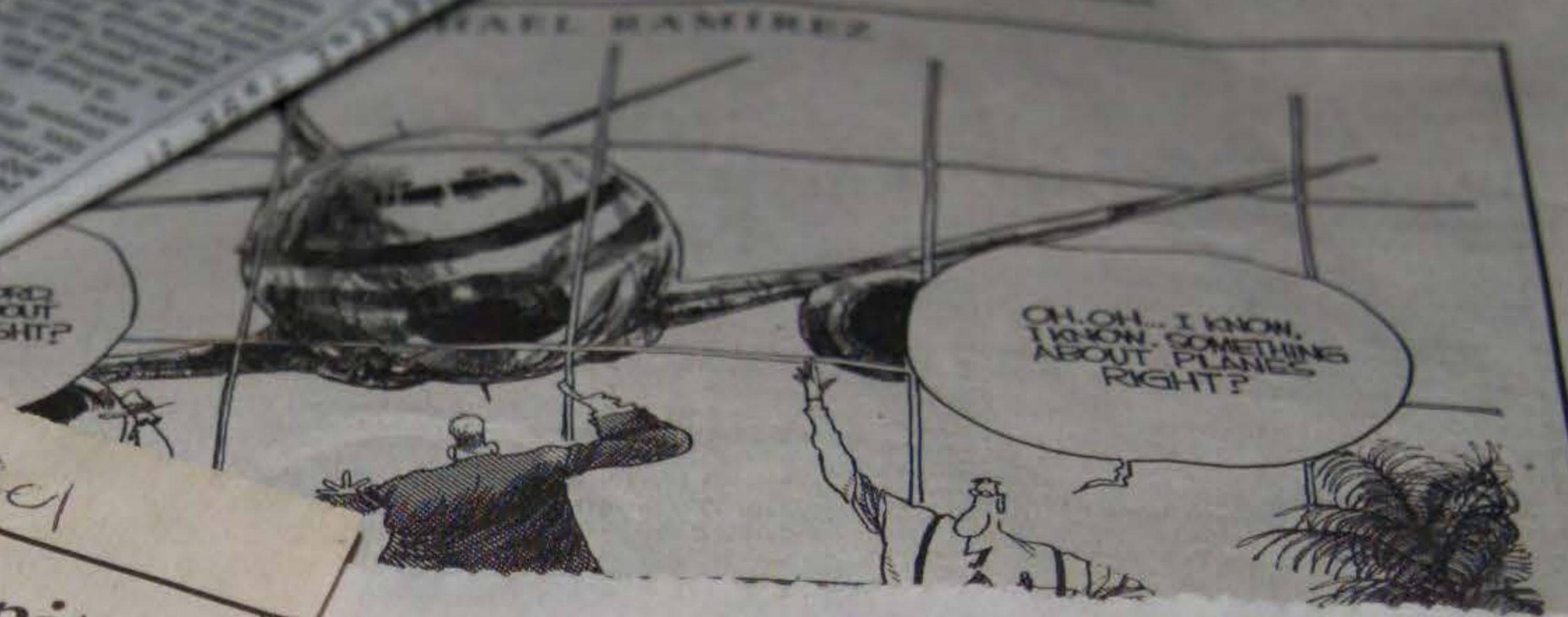

CalPAX would place "absolutely no less of any kind" before California investigators. He then offered to testify—an offer that state regulators appear inclined to accept.

CalPAX Systems itself is going to account for this," said a spokesman who has concluded that the work of the state last year was a result of improper business practices and could have been avoided.

CalPAX could not be reached for comment Wednesday. CalPAX Systems' stock price fell \$1.25 per share, or about 1%, to close at \$14.00 on the New York Stock Exchange. The group would not disclose the amount of the state's investment.

The company was hired in 1997 to help set up the computer systems for the California Power Exchange, the body that was supposed to be the state's primary power market but that went out of business last year during the height of the energy crisis, and the California Independent System Operator.

CalPAX handles real-time electricity trading and manages the power grid for most of the state. CalPAX Systems was one of three firms hired by CalPAX as part of a \$17-million contract to establish the computer system, according to the agency, which said it subcontracted with the company starting in 1998.
