**OFFICER'S NARRATIVE**

**On 12/23/19, I was working uniformed patrol in the unincorporated area of Ojai as 3A11 with Senior Deputy Molina (#3664).**

**At approximately 1630 hours, I responded to a call of a "drunk in public" male subject disturbing. The call was in the Rainbow Bridge grocery store off Matilija Street in the city of Ojai. The call came in as a male in camouflage pants disturbing customers in the grocery store. The owner of the grocery store wanted the disturbing male removed because he was scaring customers.**

**I parked on Matilija Street and walked towards the shopping center parking lot. I could see Deputy Hermann standing facing a man sitting on the curb line in the center of the parking lot. I stood near Deputy Hermann and served as cover while he spoke with the man on the curb. Sergeant Seery (3S2) was present when we arrived, but left upon our arrival.**

**The man on the curb, identified as (A) Jeffrey Gore, had slurred speech, red watery eyes and spoke in circles about seeing a friend and his homosexuality. He was wearing camouflage pants. He could not answer Deputy Hermann's questions and had to be redirected several times.**

**Deputy Hermann told Gore to stand up and place his hands behind his back. Gore stood up and said something to the effect of, "If I stand up, you lose." Gore placed his hands on the back of his head and faced away from us. His fingers were interlocked and he would not comply when Deputy Hermann told him to move his hands lower, behind his back. Deputy Hermann and Senior Deputy Molina grasped each of Gore's arms and attempted to pull them behind his back so he could be handcuffed.**

**Gore turned and broke free of Senior Deputy Molina's grasp. I then grasped Gore's free right arm and placed the arm in between my right arm and my body to lock it in place. I thought Gore may try and punch Deputy Hermann or I based on his earlier statement. Gore continued to try to walk and pull away from us. Senior Deputy Molina was able to place handcuffs on Gore's left wrist, but could not reach the handcuffs to his right wrist. We continued to struggle with Gore in a standing position and could not control his movements.**

**Deputy Hermann said, "I'm going to take him down." I knew Deputy Hermann meant we needed to take Gore to the ground to better control him. I felt Gore fall to the ground and I followed him on his right side. I lost control of Gore's right arm in the fall. I quickly knelt down beside Gore and pried his right arm out from under his upper body. I placed his right hand behind his lower back. I placed a second set of handcuffs through the handcuffs already in place on Gore's left wrist. The second set extended enough to go around his right wrist and I was able to secure it.**

**I patted Gore down for any weapons and rolled him to his right side. Gore complained of pain on his left arm. Deputy Hermann radioed for dispatch to send fire and an ambulance to our location to give medical attention to Gore.**

**Venture Fire Engine #21 and Lifeline Ambulance #503 arrived on scene and treated Gore.**

**I spoke with Deputy Hermann while Gore was being treated. The following is a summary of the conversation:**

**Deputy Hermann said Gore kicked him in the leg. He pointed to his right thigh as the area which Gore made contact. Deputy Hermann said Gore made contact with his [Deputy Hermann's] right thigh with his [Gore's] left foot. Deputy Hermann then felt Gore pull his left leg forward as if he was going to kick him again. He said before Gore could kick him again, Deputy Hermann took Gore to the ground.**

**The ambulance transported Gore to Ojai Hospital due to the possible injury on his left arm. I followed the ambulance in my patrol vehicle with Senior Deputy Molina. Deputy Hermann also relocated to the Ojai Hospital. Refer to Deputy Hermann, Deputy Havelka and Sergeant Seery's reports for further details.**

**The incident was captured on my body worn camera, but was slightly obstructed by my jacket. Refer to Senior Deputy Molina's body camera footage for a clearer video recording of incident.**

**Sergeant Seery was on scene.**

**OFFICER'S NARRATIVE**

On 12-23-19, I was working as a uniformed patrol sergeant in a marked black and white Chevrolet Tahoe out of the Ojai Police Department as "3S2". At approximately 1632 hours, I responded to the "647f Drunk In Public" call at Rainbow Bridge, 211 East Matilija Street, Ojai.

I was first to arrive at the location and parked in the alley on the south side of the store. I walked around to the front (west side) of the store and saw three people standing in front of the store looking west. I saw a subject matching the description of the disturbing party (DP) that Sheriff's Dispatch broadcasted (camouflage pants) standing in the parking lot to the west of the store, talking to an unknown male.

The three people appeared to be store employees. I contacted them and asked them if there was a crime. They said no and said that the subject was "very belligerent". I asked them if they wanted me to give the subject a trespass advisement, that if the subject returned to the store, he would be arrested for trespassing. They said yes.

I walked to the two males in the parking lot. I recognized the male in the camouflage pants as (A) Jeffery Gore, whom I know from prior contacts. Gore appeared to be under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs and was very animated and made quick, jerky movements. His speech was slurred and rapid, his eyes were red, and his face looked red and ruddy. He was somewhat agitated, but was somewhat obeying directions.

Deputy Hermann #5251 (1A11) arrived onscene and contacted Gore at the same time I did. Refer to Deputy Hermann's report for details of the contact and his actions. Senior Deputy Molina #3664 and Deputy Glaubke #5249 (3A11) arrived onscene as back up for Deputy Hermann. The scene seemed stable so I left and contacted a woman in front of Rainbow Bridge who wished to speak with me about an unrelated situation.

After speaking to the woman, I walked back to my patrol car and left the scene. As I was driving past the north entrance to the parking lot in front of Rainbow Bridge, I saw Senior Deputy Molina, Deputy Glaubke, and Deputy Hermann trying to gain control of Gore. It looked like the deputies were trying to take Gore into custody but he was resisting by trying to get away. I pulled into the parking lot and stopped in front of Gore and the deputies. I then saw the deputies take Gore to the ground. I did not see exactly how they all ended up on the ground, I just saw the pile of people go to the ground.

As I walked up to the pile, Gore yelled, "Police brutality!" I told Gore to stop resisting and calm down. Gore was trying to pull his hands and arms away from the deputies and was flailing his legs. I secured Gore's feet and legs by crossing Gore's feet and ankles and holding them down. The deputies were then able to get Gore's wrists handcuffed with two pairs of handcuffs.

After Gore was secured, he was yelling that his left shoulder was dislocated. Gore said he was in pain and was moaning and groaning. He was cussing and telling deputies not to touch him. Deputies tried to assist Gore to a standing position, but he began yelling saying his arm was broken. Deputy Hermann requested fire and rescue personnel to respond. I told deputies to leave Gore where he was. I told Gore not to move and emergency personnel were on the way to tend to him. Deputy Havelka #4745 (1B11) arrived at the location. I had him canvass the area for any possible witnesses.

Fire and rescue personnel arrived and tended to Gore. During the medical assessment one of Gore's hands was removed from the handcuffs. Deputies stood closely by for security. When Gore was loaded on a gurney by fire and rescue personnel, Gore's handcuffs were repositioned so that his right arm was cuffed to the right rail of the gurney and his left arm was cuffed to the left rail. After Gore was put in the ambulance, he was still volatile and was yelling and moving around. Lifeline then transported him to the Ojai ER. Deputies followed the ambulance to the hospital.

I recorded my initial arrival at the scene, my second arrival, and most of my contact with Gore on my Body Worn Camera (BWC). I later uploaded my footage to the server at the Ojai Police Department. Refer to reports written by Deputy Hermann, Senior Deputy Molina, Deputy Glaubke, and Deputy Havelka for further details of the incident.

**OFFICER'S NARRATIVE - USE OF FORCE**

On 12/23/19, I worked uniformed patrol assigned to the unincorporated county areas of Ojai as 3A11. At about 1631 hours, Deputy Glaubke #5249 who is currently assigned to the Field Training Officer (FTO) program and I responded to Rainbow Bridge, located at 211 Matilja Street in Ojai, reference a disturbance.

Upon arrival Deputy Hermann #5251 (1A11) was speaking with a male subject who from prior contacts I recognized as (A) Jeffrey Gore. Gore is a known transient, who stays in the Ojai area. In addition Gore is currently on probation with search terms (Case # 2019012266 / 2019018708). Deputy Hermann was speaking with Gore, who was sitting on a curb in the front parking lot outside of Rainbow Bridge.

As I approached, I could hear Gore arguing with Deputy Hermann. Gore appeared intoxicated, was slurring his words, had watery eyes, an unkempt appearance and appeared to be having trouble remaining calm. Gore was switching back and forth between talking, crying and yelling. Gore admitted to Deputy Hermann that he had been drinking beer during the day. Based on Gore's actions and demeanor it appeared Gore was intoxicated.

Deputy Hermann asked Gore to stand and place his hands behind his back. Gore stood, turned away from Deputy Hermann and placed his hands behind his neck. Deputy Hermann began to approach Gore to place handcuffs on Gore's wrist. Gore pulled away attempting to leave.

Due to Gore's actions, Deputy Hermann grabbed Gore's left arm and Deputy Glaubke grabbed Gore's right arm. I stepped behind Gore and attempted to place Gore's hands in handcuffs. I placed a handcuff on Gore's left wrist as Gore continued to pull away. I began telling Gore to stop resisting. Gore was yelling, and would not place his hands behind his back. I continued telling Gore to stop resisting and to remain calm.

Unable to place Gore's hands behind his back, Deputy Hermann told me that he was going to take Gore to the ground. I observed Deputy Hermann lean backwards towards the ground, while keeping ahold of Gore. Gore's body immediately followed Deputy Hermann's body to the ground. Deputy Hermann landed on the ground with his back hitting against the parking lot. Gore's body was on the ground, with his chest against the parking lot. Gore continued attempting to move his arms, avoiding being placed in handcuffs. With Gore lying on the ground, Deputies Hermann and Glaubke were able to gain control of Gore's arms and place them behind his back. We placed a handcuff on Gore's right wrist, connecting two pairs behind his back to allow Gore more movement.

Once Gore was handcuffed he began yelling that his shoulder was dislocated. Due to Gore's complaints of pain an ambulance was requested. Gore was treated at the scene for a possible injury to his left arm, and transported to the Ojai Hospital Emergency Room. Deputies Hermann, Glaubke and I followed the ambulance to the hospital, where Gore received medical attention. Refer to additional reports with the same RB number for further information.

This incident was recorded via my body worn camera. The video was downloaded as evidence.

Sgt. Seery (3S2) was on scene.

On 12/23/2019, I was assigned to work uniformed patrol in the City of Ojai as 1B11. At approximately 1656 hours, I responded to 211 East Matilija Street reference a PC 647(f) subject.

Upon arrival, I contacted Sergeant Seery #3586 (3S2) in public parking lot just west of the Rainbow Bridge Grocery Store. (A) Jeffrey Gore was lying on the ground and was handcuffed. Senior Deputy Molina #3664 (3A11), Deputy Glaubke #5249 (3A11), and Deputy Hermann #5251 (1A11) were standing by with Gore. Ventura County Fire Station #21 had just arrived on scene to medically evaluate Gore. Sergeant Seery directed me to interview any witnesses standing in front of Rainbow Bridge. I interviewed [REDACTED] in front of the store. The following was a summary of his statements:

Gore caught [REDACTED]'s attention prior to the police contact. [REDACTED] described Gore's intoxicated state as, "Not doing well." [REDACTED] had parked his vehicle on Signal Street to make a phone call and saw Gore sitting on the rock wall at the corner of Signal Street and Matilija Street. [REDACTED] described his movements as "erratic." [REDACTED] could hear Gore's voice "escalating to a high degree." [REDACTED] finished his phone call and pulled his vehicle around to Matilija Street. Deputies had contacted Gore at this time.

I asked [REDACTED] if he saw the deputies take Gore down to the ground. At first, [REDACTED] said, "no," then followed up with, "Yeah, I saw it." [REDACTED] explained he was over in front of Rainbow Bridge (pointed in that direction). [REDACTED] said the deputies had Gore upright, and Gore was resisting. I asked [REDACTED] "How was he resisting?" [REDACTED] responded, "I'm not sure, I couldn't see from over there." [REDACTED] could hear Gore yelling. I asked [REDACTED] if Gore was handcuffed, and he responded, "I think they were trying to handcuff him." [REDACTED] said he saw additional deputies assist taking Gore to the ground. [REDACTED] had no additional information.

Earlier in the day (12/23/2019), at approximately 0917 hours, I contacted Gore at Ojai Chevron. I was dispatched to the location because there was a male subject panhandling who refused to leave when contacted of Ojai Chevron employees. Senior Deputy Molina, Deputy Glaubke, and Deputy Hermann all arrived on scene. I recognized Gore from prior law enforcement contacts and know he suffered from alcohol and substance abuse. During my contact, I determined Gore was intoxicated based on the smell of alcohol coming from his person and his mannerisms. Gore did not meet the criteria for PC 647(f), public intoxication. I advised Gore to stop drinking and not come back to Ojai Chevron for the remainder of the day. Gore agreed and left the area. The contact was captured on body worn camera. Refer to call #19-198494 for further information.

At approximately 1105 hours, I was dispatched to Libbey Park reference a white male, dark jacket, camouflage pants, and black backpack who was extremely inebriated, talking loudly and cussing. The description given by Sheriff's Dispatch matched what Gore was wearing in the prior contact. Deputy Lathrop #5066 (3A12) and I searched the park, but did not find Gore.

After seeing the condition Gore was in at 1656 hours, outside of Rainbow Bridge, he appeared to be more intoxicated than my initial contact at 0917 hours.

Sergeant Seery was advised to the results of the interview.

On 12/23/2019, I was working uniformed patrol assigned to the City of Ojai, California as 1A11.

At approximately 1623 hours, I responded to Rainbow Bridge at 211 East Matilija Street reference a possible intoxicated subject. Sheriff's Dispatch advised a male subject wearing camo pants was causing a disturbance at the location and scaring customers.

Upon my arrival, Sergeant Seery #3586 (3S2) was on scene and talking to employees in front of Rainbow Bridge. Refer to Sergeant Seery's report for details of his actions. I saw (A) Jeffrey Gore in the parking lot speaking to an unknown male. I recognized Gore from another subject disturbing call earlier in the day at a different location.

**During that first contact, Gore appeared to be under the influence of alcohol but did not meet the criteria for PC 647(f) Public Intoxication.**

**Senior Deputy Molina #3664 and Deputy Glaubke #5249 (3A11) arrived on scene. Refer to their supplemental reports for details of their actions during this incident.**

**I contacted Gore in the parking of Rainbow Bridge and had him sit down on a nearby curb. I asked Gore about the incident in Rainbow Bridge. During my contact with Gore, he appeared agitated, made non-sensical statements, slurred his words, had an odor of alcohol about his person, and was unable to maintain a consistent train of thought. Gore repeatedly clenched his hands into fists and attempted to stand up twice.**

**Gore told me the following in summary: Gore had been going around town talking to his friends. Gore had drank two "tall cans" of beer after my initial contact with him in the morning. Gore refused to tell me the type of beer he drank and asked if I wanted to "trace me around like a dog." At one point Gore stated, "When I get up then you lose."**

**Based on Gore's behavior, his intoxicated appearance, and his statement of drinking two "tall cans" of beer after our initial contact, I believed Gore was too intoxicated to care for himself in violation of PC 647(f) Public Intoxication.**

**I instructed Gore to stand up and put his hands behind his back. Gore stood up, faced away from me, and interlaced his fingers behind his head. I could see Gore's fingers whiten as he tensed his hands. I told Gore to relax and to put his hands behind his back. I grabbed Gore's right arm with both of my hands and Senior Deputy Molina grabbed Gore's left arm. I again told Gore to put his hands behind his back. Gore stated, "I'm not going in." Gore continued to grip his hands together behind his head and resisted our attempts to place him into handcuffs. I repeatedly told Gore to relax and put his hands behind his back. Gore pulled his arms from our grip and turned to face me. Gore raised his hands and clenched them into fists. I believed Gore may attempt to punch me.**

**I grabbed Gore's left arm with both my hands while Deputy Glaubke grabbed his right arm. We attempted to control Gore's arms while Senior Deputy Molina placed Gore into handcuffs. Senior Deputy Molina was able to secure Gore's left wrist into a handcuff but we could not get his right arm close enough to secure it. We continually told Gore to stop resisting.**

**I had my upper left arm over the back of Gore's upper left arm and my left wrist under his left forearm. I then grabbed my right wrist with my left hand, put my right hand on Gore's left forearm, and put upward pressure on Gore's arm to effect an arm lock. Gore continued to struggle, I felt his left leg kick backwards, and his left foot struck my upper right leg with minimal force. I felt Gore bring his left leg forward and believed he was going to kick me in the leg again. I decided to take Gore to the ground to better control his movements and prevent him from kicking me further.**

**I told my partners I was going to take Gore to the ground. I attempted to sweep Gore's legs with my left leg but was unable to take him down. I then pulled Gore towards me, put my left leg in front of his legs, and used my weight to bring him to the ground. I landed on the left side of my back and Gore landed on top of my chest on his left side. I continued to control Gore's arm in an arm lock while Senior Deputy Molina attempted to secure Gore in handcuffs. Senior Deputy Molina retrieved a second set of handcuffs as Deputy Glaubke and I continued to struggle to control Gore.**

Gore continued to resist my efforts to hold his arm behind his back. As I put pressure on Gore's arm to keep it behind his back, I felt and heard a popping sound. Senior Deputy Molina was able to secure Gore into handcuffs. Gore complained of pain in his left arm and said it was dislocated.

I radioed for Fire and AMR to respond to our location for Gore's possible injury. Fire Engine 21 and Lifeline 503 responded to the scene to evaluate Gore. Lifeline 503 transported Gore to the Ojai Emergency Room for further evaluation. Senior Deputy Molina and Deputy Glaubke followed the ambulance, in their patrol unit, to the emergency room.

Prior to responding to the emergency room, I checked the area where a witness told Deputy Havelka #4745 (1B11) that Gore had left his backpack. The witness also recalled Gore's bizarre aggressive behavior prior to our contact. Refer to Deputy Havelka's supplemental report for details of the witness' statement.

I located a backpack in the area the witness indicated and recognized it as the backpack Gore had with him during our first contact. Next to the backpack I saw a 40 ounce bottle of Hurricane malt liquor. The bottle was mostly empty and had approximately an inch of liquid left in the bottle. I took a photograph of the bottle with my department issued iPhone and uploaded it via iShot. I discarded the bottle in a nearby trashcan.

At the Ojai Emergency Room, an x-ray was done of Gore's left arm and the nurse told me the x-ray showed a broken left humerus. Gore also sustained some abrasions to the left side of his forehead and his upper left cheek. The abrasion on his forehead was approximately five inches long, two inches tall, and reddish in color. The abrasion on his cheek was approximately two inches in diameter and reddish in color.

Based on Gore's actions, and the totality of the circumstances, I arrested Gore for violations of PC 647(f) Public Intoxication, PC 148(a)(1)Resisting, Delaying, or Obstructing a Peace Officer, and PC 243(b) Battery Upon a Peace Officer.

Deputy Urton #4511 (1A21) responded to the hospital to relieve me. Deputy Urton later informed me that the Ojai Emergency Room placed a splint on Gore's left arm and cleared him to be booked into custody. Deputy Urton transported and booked Gore into the Pre-Trial Detention Facility (PTDF) without incident.

Deputy Glaubke took digital photos of Gore's injuries with her department issued iPhone. I uploaded those photos via iShot. I uploaded my body worn camera footage of the incident to Evidence.com

I later canvassed the area around Rainbow Bridge to locate any surveillance cameras that may have captured the incident. I was unable to locate any cameras that covered that area of the parking that.

Sergeant Seery #3586 (3S2) was notified of all details of the incident and made the use of force notifications.
